

AAC Board of Directors- Unofficial Meeting Highlights for January 2024

Highlights of the AAC Board meeting held on Wednesday January 17, 2024. The full text of all motions will be found in On Course.

- 1. The BOD approved fifty-one new members.
- 2. No nominations were received for the position of Regional Director, NS/NFLD/LAB. Members in the Region will be sent an e-mail looking for a volunteer. In the meantime, Steve Borda, Regional Director for NB/PEI will cover the vacancy.
- 3. The bid by Pawsitively Regionals to host the NB/PEI Regionals at the Princess Louise Park, Sussex, NB, on June 8-9, 2024, was approved.
- 4. National Team News Fundraising activities are ongoing please support the team as it prepares for competition.
- 5. Due to an increase in the number of incidents involving bullying and inappropriate conduct, the Board is considering changing how Discipline and Appeals Committee decisions are published in On Course.
- 6. A request from the Board to review the rules with respect to Open Special events has been referred to the Standing Rules Committee.
- 7. Rulebook s. 2.8.3 Re-Measurement and Challenges to a Dog's Final Jump Height has been revised for clarity and to establish consequences for not having a challenge measurement carried out. Effective July 1, 2024.
- Rulebook Table 3.1.7- Expert Titles Required for Versatility Awards has been revised to clarify that the awarding of a Versatility Platinum (VPA) requires 5 *different* expert platinum titles and the awarding of a Versatility Platinum Excellent (VPX) requires 6 *different* expert platinum titles. This change is effective immediately.
