



### **AAC Board of Directors – Meeting Highlights (unofficial)**

Highlights of the AAC Board meeting held on Thursday, November 15, 2018.

1. 2019 AB/NWT Regional Championships

Performance Agility Club of Edmonton to host the 2019 AB/NWT Regional Agility Championship on June 14-16, 2019 at William F. Lede Rugby Field, Leduc, AB.

2. A revised 2018-2019 National Team was updated to reflect the increased team size permitted by IFCS their 2019 event.

3. From January 1, 2019, check-in trial registration (excluding Regional and National events) will return to AAC AT the Trial standard check-in protocol, as outlined in Section 2.2.4 of the AAC 2018 Rulebook. This will include a return to the requirement that only dogs that require a measurement in order to compete, or dogs new to trials at that club, will be required to produce their dog's ID cards at trials.
